### ASSASSINS TOURNAMENT- Grande bataille 1023

#### TOURNAMENT RULES

- Each player is allowed only one dagger (30 cm) per player.
- Armor is not taken into account.
- Assassination occurs when a blow is struck to the body (chest and back) or the head.
- If a blow is struck to a limb, you can choose to fight or flee. Afterwards, your limb regenerates.
- The minimum age requirement is 16 years.
- NO assistance is allowed from non-participants.
- Players cannot form teams.
- The armband must be worn on the LEFT arm, between the shoulder and elbow, and must be visible, not concealed by any clothing, cape, or other items.
- To count as an assassination, both pieces of the armband must be taken from the victim during the assassination and returned to the organizers.
- Once you lose your armband, you cannot commit any more assassinations until the end of the game.
- If you manage to stay alive until the end of the tournament, your armband will be included in your total.
- The tournament begins at 9:00 PM with the sound of trumpets and ends at 10:30 PM with the sound of trumpets. You are free to arrive at any time, but once the armband is put on, you cannot remove it until the end (unless you are assassinated).
- The tournament takes place inside the Old Town.
- There will be referees present and identifiable, but they will not assist you.
- In case of rule violations, the referees reserve the right to disqualify players.

At the end of the activity at 10:30 PM or upon your death, go to the Cavaliers du Bouc kiosk at the Troll Ball field to register your assassinations. In case of a tie, a duel will be organized.
