PARTICIPATION APPLICATION

The Bataille de Bicolline is a major event that brings together over 7,000 participants each year for seven immersive days. It provides a great opportunity for vendors and artisans to gain visibility and connect directly with an enthusiastic audience. This unique setting encourages product discovery and fosters the building of lasting relationships with customers.

RIGHT OF SALE FEES

The initial vending fee includes the following:

- 1 sales space of 100 square feet (10 x 10). Additional fees apply for any extra selling area;
- 1 seven-day event registration (for the contact person);
- 1 nearby parking space;
- Access to setup days on Friday, August 7 and Saturday, August 8.

Fees

Initial vending fee (100 sq. ft.): **\$550 + tax**

Additional space: **\$2.75 + tax per square foot**

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

All vendors and artisans, along with their pre-registered employees, may arrive on Friday (August 7) or Saturday (August 8) before the event to check in and set up their equipment.

For departure, vehicles will be allowed on-site only from 9:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 16, when the event concludes.



LOCATION AND SALE SPACES

The merchants' and artisans' district is located in the decorum zone, in the Upper Town, near the Auberge de Bicolline and the main entrance to the site.

This is the only authorized sales area for all vendors and artisans offering products or services, and a vending authorization issued by the Duché de Bicolline is required. Itinerant (roaming) sales are not permitted.

Three types of setups are allowed for selling:

1. Medieval-style tent or marquee
2. Building
3. Rental kiosk

RENTAL OF A KIOSK OR BUILDING

Wooden booths measuring 10' x 10', equipped with lift-up panels on three sides, are available for rent at a cost of \$595 + tax for the duration of the event.

Bicolline also has a limited number of larger buildings available. For more information on options and pricing, please contact us directly.

OTHER SERVICES AVAILABLE FOR MERCHANTS AND ARTISANS

Parking: A parking space near the merchants' and artisans' district is provided for your vehicles and trailers. The parking area will be accessible daily for your use, as needed.

Electricity and Internet Access: All buildings located in the merchants' district can be supplied with electricity and connected to a network cable for an additional fee of \$135 + tax for the duration of the event.

EMPLOYEES

All employees of the vendor or artisan must be registered for the event for the duration of their stay on site.

For every additional 100 square feet of sales space (excluding the initial 100 square feet included in the vending fee), the vendor or artisan receives a 50% discount on one adult event registration. A maximum of 5 additional registrations at a 50% discount is allowed.

Examples:

EXAMPLE A

A vendor is attending alone and has a 10 x 10 ft booth. They must pay the following fees:

- Initial vending fee: \$550 + tax (includes 100 square feet of sales space and one event registration)

EXAMPLE B

A vendor is attending with 3 employees (4 people total) and has 300 square feet of sales space. They must pay the following fees:

- Initial vending fee: \$550 + tax (includes 100 square feet of sales space and one event registration)
- \$550 + tax for additional sales space (200 square feet at \$2.75 + tax)
- They must pay for 2 registrations at a 50% discount and 1 registration at full price (two discounted registrations based on the additional 200 square feet, and one at the regular rate).

WORKSHOPS

Artisans and vendors who wish to do so may offer workshops to enhance the experience of participants (ex: introduction to leatherworking, woodworking, or other crafts).

You are free to define the format of your workshop according to your preferences, including duration, pricing, schedule, and number of participants. Activities take place directly in your shop, and you remain responsible for managing registrations and payments.

Bicolline, for its part, will highlight your offering by promoting it on its website and social media, and by directing participants to your contact information for registration.
